Thank you for your participation at the first PCCAS Recycling Committee meeting. I believe the meeting was very productive and informative. The following is a brief summary of the meeting. You will receive more comprehensive meeting notes at a later date.

**Objectives of Committee:**

- 1) To develop end-result specifications that may be used by Department of Transportations (DOTs) and local agencies.
- 2) To provide recommendations for training and implementation to the DOTs and local agencies.
- 3) To acquire funding through national organizations such as FHWA and NAPA in order to establish either a recycle center in the west coast area or collaborate with other existing centers.

**Action Items:**

- 1) All DOTs will provide a copy of their recycling specifications (cold, hot, foamed, and other rehabilitation processes that are considered recycling) to me by November 17th. This information will be posted on the PCCAS web site.
- 2) A draft copy of the specifications for each process will be forwarded to you for review and comments. Based on your comments, the specifications will be finalized. The goal is to have a draft copy by the end of the year and final copy by May 2007.
- 3) Steve Landers of WSDOT and Larry Ilg of OR DOT will provide the status of recycling in their states, including the challenges of accomplishing more recycling.

Steve and I appreciate your work on this very important task and we are very confident that your effort will result in a very useful product. Again, many thanks.
