Minutes for PCCAS Recycling Meeting

October 25-26, 2016

1. Call to Order:

 - 2.3: Work in conjunction with the Paving/Asphalt Mixture Committee regarding performance of higher RAP/RAS.
 - 2.4: Evaluate the feasibility of using RAP in slurry mixes.
- **3. Foamed Asphalt Presentation:**

Don Matthews opened the meeting with an updated presentation on Foamed asphalt Cold-In-Place recycling. The presentation cover highlights of foaming aspects of the hot asphalt cement, Portland cement, mix design and observation of field evaluations. General discussions followed. 4. Performance of Cold Recycled Mixtures:

No new information was available for the meeting. Caltrans is exploring the potential of evaluating higher emulsion contents and higher cement contents CIR projects done several years ago.

5. Performance of Hot Recycled Pavements in service:

Steven Escobar raised the concerns of some agencies that HMA's containing RAP were not performing as well to HMAs not containing RAP. Earlier raveling and aging appearance (faster graying of pavements) were noted. Further discussions were delayed to Asphalt Mixture Committee meeting the next day.

6. Research Updates from the University of Nevada-Reno on CIR Mix Designs:

7. State Updates:

Alaska: 15% RAP California: 15% RAP no change, 15-25% use blending chart. Oregon: 30% RAP. Nevada: 15% RAP. Washington: Up to 40% Binder replacement on RAP, 5% RAS. Western Federal Land Department: 20% RAP.
